

## **SALT Graduation Ceremony**

SALT hosts a yearly graduation ceremony for its senior class. The event takes place the Saturday after the SALT calendar year ends. Parents of graduating seniors organize and carry out each element of the ceremony, including the following details:

- Scheduling class graduation pictures
- Ordering caps, gowns, and tassels (group discount)
- Ordering diplomas (group discount)
- Reserving location for ceremony
- Preparing graduation slideshow
- Selecting speaker
- Printing graduation program
- Purchasing refreshments for reception

Students are *not required* to participate in our graduation ceremony, but it is a wonderful opportunity to celebrate formally with friends and family. In order to qualify for participation, a student must enroll in at least one class with SALT during their senior year, attend some of the \*SALT junior/senior activities, and have a clear balance on all monies owed to SALT.

As far as academic graduation requirements, we understand that each family selects the classes their students will take throughout high school, but we do encourage parents to have their college bound students follow TEA graduation guidelines when completing their high school curriculum. Meeting these basic course requirements aid the student in the college application and scholarship process.
